#### **Additional English/Maths Teaching Posts - £64,828**

The number of English and Maths lessons for Year 7 and 8 have been increased to improve literacy and numeracy skills.

#### **Literacy & Numeracy HLTAs - £37,053**

Literacy HLTAs deliver small group/ 1-1 interventions in reading, spelling, handwriting, keyboard skills, comprehension, paired reading and speech and language.

They also support Homework Club after school from 3-4 after school Mon to Thurs.

Numeracy HLTAs support in Maths lessons but also deliver small group/ 1-1 intervention.

#### **Forest School and Animal Care - £16,109**

Member of staff employed to work with students to deliver Forest School to identified Pupil Premium students in Year 8 and to deliver Animal care to students in 9, 10 and 11 as part of the options programme

#### **EWO - £5,000**

Employed to improve attendance across the school. To narrow attendance gaps between PP and non PP students.

#### **Effective Learning Centre (ELC) - £36,651**

The Effective Learning Centre (ELC) provides behaviour support and intervention for some of our most vulnerable/ difficult students. Those students based in the ELC benefit from small group support to remove barriers and allow students to more successfully access their learning. High proportion of PP students.

#### **Pastoral Leads - £48,359**

We now have 6 non-teaching Pastoral Heads of Year. 2 are paid for out of the PP budget. Their roles vary but include sorting any issues within the year group including, safeguarding, attendance, behaviour, improve links with parents and outside agencies, bullying, and mentoring students.

#### **Sound Training - £10,000**

School have purchased the Sound Training licence and have had 5 staff trained in delivering this programme. This is a 6 week course for 1 lesson a week delivered in 1 hour on a rolling programme

#### **Education Off Site - £3,300**

Pupil Premium funding used to support activities at Cornwall College, and the Pupil Referral Unit or anything additional these students required to remove barriers to learning.

#### **General - £14,000**

Financial support for Pupil Premium students: Uniform, trips, revision books, equipment, prom.
